He proposed an increase to the contract and an additional \$84,696 was approved and retroactive to July. Going forward, meetings will take place in April to renegotiate and discuss increases. <u>Budget</u>

A. Walton Learning Center Budget 2022-2023 – Kara presented the budget for Walton Learning Center restating that the new annual rate increased by \$84,696 from

\$442,304 to \$527,000. Mr. Neale asked for a motion to approve the budget. Mr. Graham made a motion, Mr. Neale seconded. Motion passed.
